Planting Instructions

Planting instructions: dig a hole as deep as the plastic pot your plant is in, and twice as wide. Mix a rich soil amendment with the native soil from the hole. Go heavier on native soil than amendment – we recommend $^{2}/_{3}$ native soil mixed with $^{1}/_{3}$ amendment. Carefully slide the plant out of the pot and place in the hole. Use the soil + amendment mix to back fill around the root ball. Water deeply immediately after planting.

<u>Watering instructions</u>: water daily by hand or with a drip system. Smaller plants need ½ to 1gallon of water per day. Larger plants need more. As temperatures cool down in late fall, watering can change to every other day. In the middle of winter, you should water plants if there is a two week dry spell. <u>Protect from</u>: deer, gophers, extreme clay soil, and the cold if necessary (ask us for help with extreme clay soil)

Our plant guarantee

We guarantee plants for 30 days from purchase date *if*:

- 1. Plants were planted immediately into the ground
- 2. Plants were watered and cared for properly
- 3. Plants were protected from gopher and deer damage

These guidelines must be followed **and** an original receipt is required for plants to be guaranteed. Guaranteed plants are replaced by a replacement plant of the same size and value. Guarantee is void on sale items, bedding plants, and indoor plants.

We guarantee plants for 1 year from purchase date *if* they are delivered and planted by our crew.

We reserve the right to void guarantees on a case-by-case basis.

Delivery & Planting Service by Solomon's Gardens Inc.

- We guarantee plants and trees for one year from purchase date if they are delivered and planted by our crew. Plants should be watered regularly by customer after planting. Irrigation installation is not included with delivery and planting of plants.
- Repair of undisclosed water mains, irrigation lines, gas lines, or electrical lines will be performed at additional time and materials cost if damaged during planting by our crews.
- Excessive large roots and/or rocks may also cause additional costs if not previously disclosed.
